

TCA DAY WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP 24 TEAM FORMAT – 2022

24 TEAM – 3 GAME GUARANTEE FORMAT

No Byes 2 days

- 2 pools of 12 teams play 3 guaranteed games format with winners of the 3rd game going to the finals.
- Games 1 & 2 are played for points where total points for the 2 games seed teams into 1 of 6 events. Each event has 4 teams participating in Game 3.
- Game 3 is straight win/loss with the winning teams advancing to the final Game 4.
- The bonspiel is played over 2 days, Tuesday November 9 and Thursday November 11.
- Tuesday host clubs are Leaside and York. Thursday host club is Thornhill.

Format

- Game 1, host club (pool) assignment and team match ups will be done in advance by random draw with 12 teams hosted at Leaside and 12 teams hosted at York. (exceptions may be made for teams who are part of the host club hosting committee)
- Game 1 & 2 are played for points – 1 point for an end, ¼ point for rock, 10 points for a win.
- Game 2 pairings are based on the results of Game 1 with 1 vs 2, 3 vs 4, 5 vs 6, ...
- Game 1 & 2 will be 8 ends but points and rocks will be counted only on the first 6 ends played. The 7th and 8th ends are only played for the win/loss
- Games 1 & 2 tie breaker will be a draw to the button. Any team member can be designated to throw one rock. Each team may sweep their own rock. Vices measure their own rock. Points assigned for tied games will be: 7 for the winner of the tie breaker, 3 for the loser
- Game 3 event assignment. The total points from Games 1 & 2 determine your event. The 12 teams from each pool (Leaside or York) will have 2 teams assigned to 6 events by numeric ranking within their pool. 1&2 Main event, 3&4 2nd event ...
- Tie breakers for determining event placement is done by
 - Head to head
 - Point differential (points for-points against)
 - Least points against
 - Coin toss
- Game 3 matchups will be Leaside 1 vs York 2, Leaside 2 vs York 1 for the main event, Leaside 3 vs York 4, Leaside 4 vs York 3 for the 2nd event, etc.
- Game 3 is straight win loss with the winning teams advancing to the finals.

- Game 4 is straight win loss with the winning teams being the event winner. Ties in Game 4 are broken by a full end towards the glass.
